23.00 Conflicting Orders

If a supervising officer finds it necessary to give an order of instructions to a subordinate of another officer, that conflicts with an order or instruction to that person by his/her immediate officer, the member/employee shall so inform the supervising officer giving the instructions.

If the supervising officer still desires that his/her order or instruction be carried out, the member/employee shall carry out those orders. The supervising officer then shall notify the member/employee shall notify the member/employee's immediate officer of this action.
